

Shipping into Mexico

All shipments into Mexico need to meet minimum requirements to be imported in a timely fashion. This includes samples. A sample for importation purposes is material that has a value of 300 US dollars or less. There are 4 basic requirements for importation of any material into Mexico.

1. HTS classification, 8 digits for Mexico. (This includes equipment, books etc.) (You can obtain the 8 digit HTS from Susana Barajas at 52.427.271.9100 ext. 344 or Vanessa Robledo at vrobledo@ppg.com)
2. A legal description of the merchandise that corresponds with the HTS. This will be assigned with the HTS by Susana or Vanessa.
3. A commercial invoice. The value cannot be "0" The commercial invoice should accompany the shipment.
4. In the case of a hazardous material, an MSDS must be included with the shipment.

Shipping Equipment into Mexico

The same requirements apply to equipment that will be shipped into Mexico. The classification can be more complex. Please send pictures or diagrams of the equipment along with a description of its use to Susana Barajas before shipping the equipment.
